### Eligibility:

Students from schools following state, CBSE, ICSE, and other curricula are eligible to appear for the Primary (4th Grade) and Upper Primary (7th Grade) Scholarship Examinations.

### Age Limit:

As of June 1st of the academic year, the maximum age should be 10 years for the 4th Grade exam and 13 years for the 7th Grade exam (14 and 17 years respectively for students with disabilities).

### Examination Fee:

These students are required to pay the prescribed fee ₹200/-.  
student have to fill form through respective school Only

### Merit Lists:

Independent State-level and District-level merit lists will be prepared specifically for CBSE and ICSE students.

- **State Level:** The top 100 students from across the entire state will be selected.
- **District Level:** The top 25 students from each district will be selected.
- **Certification and Recognition:** Students appearing in these merit lists will be awarded a Certificate of Merit and their rank will be communicated.
- **Note on Cash Prize:** According to the government decision, these students will receive certificates and rankings but will not be eligible for the cash scholarship amount.
